- Saturday 16 November – Conway Road and Romilly Crescent
- Saturday 23 November – Pontcanna Street, Platurton Gardens, Platurton Avenue and Platurton Place
- Saturday 30 November – Talbot Street, Ryder Street and Pitman Street
- Sunday 1 December – Severn Grove and Turberville Place
- Saturday 7 December – Neville Street, Dispenser Street, Wyndham Street and South Morgan Place/Wellington Street

START TIME 10AM, THE COUNCIL TEAMS WILL ARRIVE AROUND 10.30AM.

- Leaves should be swept into small piles on the road, or into the middle.
- Please focus on the spaces that are inaccessible to the mechanical sweepers.
 - You can use your garden waste sacks or other containers which can easily be tipped into the vehicles by the council workers
- Please move your cars if possible, and focus on clearing around parked cars.
- 'The Big Sweep' will go ahead whatever the weather - Thank you for taking part!
